


# The Curious Case of Miss Grey

# Cruising from Belfast

Belfast Harbour is Northern Ireland's principal maritime gateway and logistics hub. The cruise terminal is 2.5 miles from Belfast City Centre. Belfast Port is conveniently located close to the motorway network off junction 1 of the M2 motorway, offering easy access from Belfast city centre and the rest of Ireland.

# How to get there

By Car

**From Belfast city centre:** Join the A2 towards York Street and turn right onto Dock Street. Follow signs for Belfast Port/Harbour.

**From M1 (South):** Leave the M1 and join the A12. Use the left lane to keep left at the fork and stay on the A12. Turn left onto York Street then turn right onto Dock Street. Dock Street turns slightly left and becomes Corry Road, then at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Dufferin Road and continue onto McCaughey Road.

From M2 (North): Head east on M2, at junction 1B exit towards A2/city centre. Take Corry Road and Dufferin Road to McCaughey Road, then continue straight onto Duncrue Street and then onto Garmoyle Street before turning left onto Dock Street. Dock Street turns slightly left and becomes Corry Road, then at the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Dufferin Road and continue onto McCaughey Road.

# Bu Rail

The nearest railway station is Great Victoria Street Station. You will then need to get a taxi or bus to the terminal.

# **Ambition Cabins**

Ambition offers a wide choice of well appointed, inviting and comfortable guest cabins spanning five accommodation decks from Boat Deck 7 up to Sun Deck 12. There are three spacious main foyer areas on all decks (except Aloe deck 4) serviced by six lifts and stairways. Aloe Deck 4 and Sun Deck 12 are serviced by two lifts in the forward and aft lobbies respectively.



With the exception of 19 purpose-built single bed configured cabins in categories 1S and 6S, all cabins are of double bed configuration (some with fold-away upper pullman berths or sofa beds), with the exception of categories 1S & 6S. In most cases, they can be converted to twin beds. The other single categories are double bed cabins for single occupancy. There are two cabins adapted for guests with disability and mobilitu needs (9051 and 9052).
